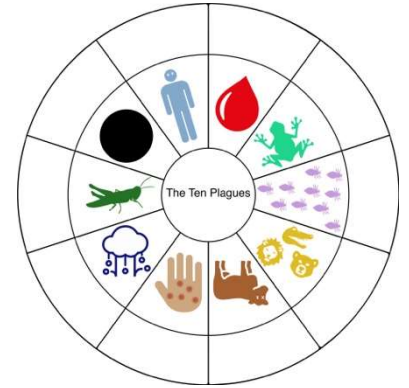




The 10 Plagues Wheel

Direction Sheet: Leader

The 10 Plagues Wheel may be used as a picture-matching game for pre-readers or as a Hebrew vocabulary matching game for older children. Participants will match the game card to the corresponding image on the 10 Plagues Wheel. When they have completed the challenge, they will show the leader the board. If correctly completed, give them the key!



Materials and Advance Preparation Needed

➤ 10 Plagues Wheel for Pre-Readers

- Print both sheets of the 10 Plagues Wheel onto 11x17" ledger paper and glue them together to form the circular game board.
- Either print the 10 plague images onto cardstock and cut into separate game cards **OR** create more of a sensory oriented experience by making tactile plague cards. Instructions below.
- Remember, gather everything you need for this puzzle, including the directions for participants, and put it into a large, numbered envelope.



Assemble the following materials to make the sensory plague cards:

- White cardstock – cut into nine or ten 2 x 3.5" rectangles to use as bases for the game cards
- Plastic frog
- Large black stone (the darkness was heavy!)
- Small pieces of fabric, including: shiny red vinyl, animal print, black felt, frog themed cotton
- Bubble wrap
- Wooden peg doll
- Markers
- White glue and paint brush
- Glue sticks and a glue gun
- Scissors
- Tan-colored rubber bands
- Red nail polish (optional)





The 10 Plagues Wheel

Decorate each plague card:

BLOOD: Glue a 2 x 3.5" piece of shiny red vinyl to the front of one game card. For added texture, dot the vinyl with red nail polish. No vinyl? Use markers to color the game card red.

FROGS: Either glue a plastic frog to one game card or make a 2 x 3.5" beanbag from the frog fabric.

LICE: Cover the front of one game card with white glue. Drop small pieces of tan rubber bands into the glue to create "lice." Let dry thoroughly.

WILD BEASTS: Glue animal print fabric to one game card.

CATTLE DISEASE: Cut out and tack down black felt spots on top of a game card.

BOILS: Color one game card a flesh tone. Glue bubble wrap on top.

HAIL: Cover one game card with white Velcro dots.

LOCUST: Glue the image of the locust (located on next page) onto one game card.

DARKNESS: Color one game card black. Glue the black stone on top. Or, just use the stone by itself.

DEATH OF THE FIRST BORN: Glue the wooden peg doll to one game card. Or, use the peg by itself.

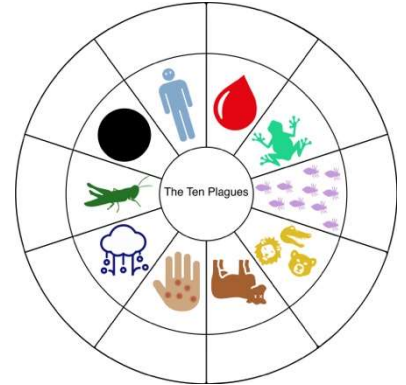
➤ The 10 Plagues Wheel – Hebrew Readers' Game

- Print both sheets of the 10 Plagues Wheel onto 11x17 ledger paper and glue them together to form the circular game board.
- Print the 10 Plagues Hebrew Vocabulary Sheet on to cardstock and cut into separate game cards.
- Collect 10 small clothes pins to hold the matching vocabulary in place.
- Include a *Haggadah* with the plagues listed in Hebrew and English for reference.

Direction Sheet: Participants (and helpers)



10 Plagues Wheel for Pre-Readers

Show your completed Wheel to the leader, and they will deliver the key!

10 Plagues Wheel for Hebrew Readers
