

Create a Beautiful Honey Pot for Rosh Hashanah

Supplies Needed:

- Votive holders; one per student
 Purchase inexpensive votive holders at Wal-Mart, IKEA, Target, or at a floral supply store. Average cost is \$.50 per piece.
- Gold and silver paint pens that will write on glass
 These are also available at Wal-Mart, Target or any craft supply store.
- Masking or clear tape

Directions:

- 1. Make copies of the *Shanah Tovah U'metuka* sheet. Cut into strips.
- 2. Have each student tape the Hebrew phrase inside the votive holder, with text facing out.
- 3. With the paint pen, trace the words on the outside of the holder. Students may wish to further embellish their honey pot with decorations, their family name, or English phrases such as: Happy New Year or Have a Sweet New Year.
