

## Beaded Honey Spoon

### Supplies Needed:

- 20, 22 or 24 gauge craft wire, 2 feet per participant
- Assorted beads
- Spoons, one per participant
- If your budget allows, bulk packs of spoons may be purchased at Target, Wal-Mart or the Dollar Store. Otherwise, sturdy plastic spoons work well too!
- Craft / jewelry pliers
- Paper apples, printed on to cardstock  
Choose from a tag with the prayer for eating apples and honey, or a tag that says  
*A Good and Sweet New Year*
- Scissors
- Ribbon
- Whole punch

### Directions:

1. Cut wire in to 2 foot pieces.
2. Wrap the wire around the neck several times to secure the wire. Tuck the “tail” underneath the wire wrap in the back of the spoon and trim so no one gets poked!
3. String a few assorted beads onto the wire. Gently wrap the beaded wire around the spoon. Add more beads to the wire and repeat. Leave enough wire at the end to be able to wrap, tuck and secure the wire as you did at the start of the project.
4. Cut out an apple tag and attach to beaded spoon with a ribbon



Please note: If you are working with younger children, pre-wrap wire around the neck of each spoon.
