



Hanukkah Coupon Booklet

A special gift for students to make for their parents

Topic: Hanukkah, *Mitzvot*, Hanukkah gift for parents

Grade Level: All

Goals for the Lesson/Activity

- Students will know (gain familiarity with) six different Jewish values
- Create a meaningful coupon booklet as a Hanukkah gift for their parents

Materials Needed

- Copies of the Hanukkah coupon page- 8 coupons per student -one for each night of Hanukkah
- Pens/pencils/markers
- Scraps of Hanukkah wrapping paper, glitter and glue to decorate coupon covers
- Poster board or card stock cut into 8 ½ by 5 ½ pieces (two pieces per student to be made into a book cover)
- Staples or whole punch and ribbons (for making booklets)

Description of Activities

Write a list on the board of all of the different values listed on the coupons. Discuss the meaning of each value. Ask students to think of one thing they might do, related to that value, that would be a gift to their family. For example, under *Caring for Animals* a student might volunteer to feed the family pet during Hanukkah, or clean the cage or take them for a walk ... Record their answers under the related value.

Distribute the coupons, 8 per student. Ask them to fill out the coupons by writing down the action they will take and checking off the connected value.

Distribute poster board or cardstock, markers, scraps of Hanukkah wrapping paper, glitter and glue. Ask students to create a front and back cover for their coupon book. Staple the books together, or using a hole punch and ribbon tie the book together.
