



## Matzah Box

### Grade Level(s)

Kindergarten and up

### Goals for the Lesson/Activity

Students will enjoy creating a beautiful Matzah box to store and display their Matzah during Passover.

### Materials needed

- Plastic tablecloth(s) to protect tables
- Square Cake pan with lid, a minimum of 8" per side, one per student
- Various colors of tissue paper
- Mod Podge
- Foam brushes
- Colored masking tape
- Small scissors
- Foam die cut frogs, several per student\*
- Die cut Hebrew letters for the word Matzah (Mem, Tzadik, Hey מצה), one set per student\*

\*If you do not have access to a die cut machine, students can decorate their Matzah box with paper versions of frogs and Hebrew letters.

### Description of Activities

1. Cover the tables. Give each student a container with a lid, a small scissors, a brush, Mod Podge and a variety of colored tissue paper.
2. Cut or tear small pieces of tissue paper.
3. Brush the Mod Podge on the outside top and sides of the container lid.
4. Apply small pieces of tissue paper everywhere you put the Mod Podge.
5. Glue the frog shapes and the foam/paper letters on top.
6. Apply another coat of Mod Podge all over the lid.
7. Put the colored masking tape around the edges of the lid as a decorative finish. Be sure to leave the underside edge uncovered so the lid still fits tightly with the container bottom.
8. Allow it to dry before using with your Matzah.
